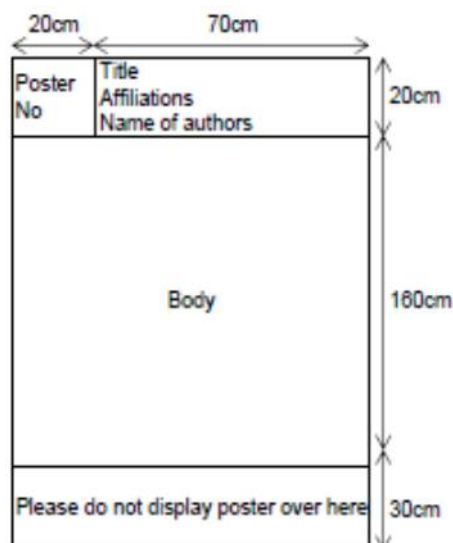
Information for Poster Presenters
